# History

- Is largest county in state: 423,000 residents
- Rural Hills. County Towns make up a large portion of our agriculture sector in state
- County Government: located in Goffstown
- 2 Cities + 29 towns

# So what happens at the county level?

County Offices are comprised of elective office holders in the following positions

**Commissioner:** Our District - District 3 (Hillsborough County has 3 Commissioners who serve 2 yr terms) - over see county realestate, contracts, programs and department requests for transfer. We have 3 Commissioners in the county

**Delegation Members** all Hillsborough County State Reps (123 of us) serve on the fiscal side of the wall approving and looking at overall transfer requests from each major department head within the county.



HB 324 – Book Ban Bill: VETOED

HB 446 – Youth Risk Behavior Survey Opt-In Mandate: VETOED

HB 667 – Forced Viewing Requirement of Fetal Development+  
Pregnancy Video in School Health Class: VETOED
